Overview

Diabetic Association Medical College, Faridpur started its journey from the 15th November 2009 and opened its door to the students of the academic year 2009-2010 (1st Batch).

After the inception, Seven batches of medical students successfully completed their graduations from this institute. At present we are enrolling 90 (Ninety) students in each year. Among them a few seats are reserved for foreign students and currently some students of India & Nepal are enrolled in different sessions.

Diabetic Association Medical College, Faridpur is an institution of Faridpur Diabetic Association (FDA) and is run by a Governing Body. It is mentionable that Faridpur Diabetic Association is the 2nd member of “International Diabetes Federation” from Bangladesh since 2009.

This Medical College is affiliated with the University of Dhaka and recognized by the Bangladesh Medical & Dental Council (BM&DC) and approved by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of Bangladesh and enlisted in the World Directory of Medical Schools.

Now the medical degree obtained from this medical college are acceptable to the provincial/territorial medical regulatory authorities in Canada and therefore acceptable to all medical organizations in Canada.

Students and graduates of this medical college are eligible for applying to Educational Commission for Foreign Medical Graduates (ECFMG) for ECFMG certification, USA.

Diabetic Association Medical College Hospital (DAMCH) is attached with the teaching hospital which is a tertiary care Hospital established in the year of 1985 and ensuring clinical services in almost all departments of medical science.

Since its establishment in the year of 2009, Diabetic Association Medical College, Faridpur has come a long way in the last years and achieved great reputation amongst the non-government medical colleges in the country. Internship Training

One year compulsory internship training as prescribed by BM&DC is the pre-requisite to obtain the registration from Bangladesh Medical and Dental Council (BM&DC) for professional practice. Diabetic Association Medical College Hospital conducts the internship training which is designed specifically to develop the necessary skill & attitudes to deal with common health problems, by working in hospital and in the community. This training is meticulously and rigorously supervised. The trainees will be entitled to appropriate subsistence allowance or honorarium (Foreigner students will be paid as per the USD exchange rate of the date of admission).

It is a 500 bedded hospital with all treatment and teaching facilities required for a medical college:

- **Cardiology Unit:** The Hospital has a reputed 80 bed cardiac unit with CCU to manage and treat cardiac patients. Cardiology unit needs to continue its upward trend in clinical activities as well as introducing advance latest facilities. We hope to install Cath-Lab in near future.
- **Kidney Dialysis Unit:** Disorders of the Kidneys and Urinary tract are well attended. TURP and other surgical interventions are done in the Urology unit. Nephrology unit is equipped with 23 Haemodialysis machines for dialysis as life support of the kidney patients.

On 14th April 2010 this unit started functioning with the donation of a haemodialysis machine by the sons of wellknown philanthropist of Faridpur late. Al-haj Adbul Karim Miah. Four machines were collected from the Ministry of Social Welfare. One machine was donated by late Chowdhury Sabbir Yousuf, the former vice president of Faridpur Diabetic Association. The unit was over-crowded with kidney patient for dialysis. Our president Mr. Mir Nasir Hossain, to overcome the situation, donated Two Haemodialysis machines, one of which is dedicated to serve the patient free of cost. National Bank Ltd. donated another one machine. Dutch-Bangla Bank Ltd. donated thirteen Haemodialysis machines. By now we have total twenty three Haemodialysis machines.

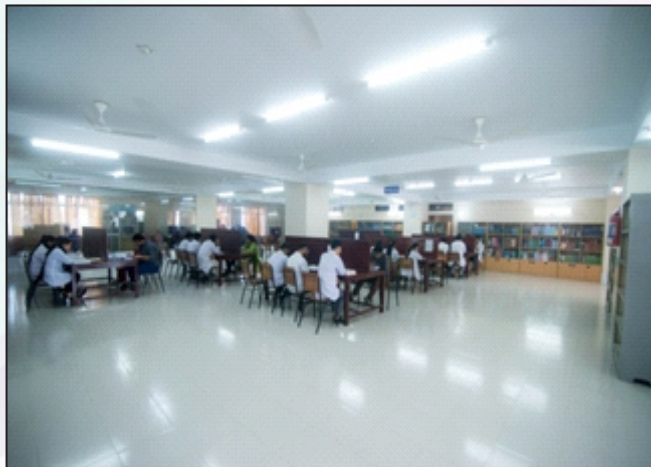

Activities

Research & Monitoring Cell

For research management and co-ordination, Diabetic Association Medical College, Faridpur has established Research and Monitoring Cell.

This cell conducts regular programs for the training of research workers and takes the responsibility to function as a focal point for all health research in this medical college. It also provides advisory services to doctors and teachers in publishing research work and journal. Journal of Diabetic Association Medical College, Faridpur (JDAMC) is published twice in a year under the supervision of an Editorial board and an Institutional Ethics Review Board (IERB)

Medical Education Unit (MEU) & Medical Skill Centre (MSC)

The Medical Education Unit (MEU) has been established, with the aim to develop the real time aptitude in the professionalism of medical teachers. Seminars and workshops are arranged regularly which enable them to exchange views with the colleagues of other disciplines. It is run by a Committee. A Professor is in charge of the overall organization and management of the unit. This committee also runs the Medical Skill Centre (MSC)

Admission to the MBBS Course

Course Offered

The Medical College offers a 5 years MBBS Course as approved by Bangladesh Medical & Dental Council (BM&DC) leading to MBBS degree of the University of Dhaka.

Eligibility

Higher Secondary Certificate (H.S.C) or equivalent degree from Science group with Biology. Students must qualify the MBBS admission test conducted by the Directorate General of Health Services (DGHS). Government of Bangladesh regulates the criteria of admission in 1st year MBBS course.

Selection

Eligible candidates need to apply in the prescribed form available from the Principal's Office of Diabetic Association Medical College, Faridpur. Merit position of all applicants will be prepared and the top listed candidates will be selected.

The full merit list will be hung on the notice board and posted to our college website and also published in the national daily newspapers.

Prospectus & Application Form

Dates of availability are advertised in national dailies and posted to our website & notice board.

Poor & Meritorious Student's Quota

Each year five poor & meritorious students (5% of total seats) get chance to study with the expenses as like as the expenses of Government Medical College. Poor & meritorious student's quota will be filled up as per rules of DGHS and Ministry of Health and Family Welfare.
